Who can participate?

Any educator who has experience working with students in grades 1–12 in a WIDA member state during the previous two years is invited to participate.

What will educators do?

Theme Generators will:

- Complete a non-disclosure agreement (NDA).
- Watch a tutorial video to understand what types of themes can be used on ACCESS for ELLs.
- Brainstorm theme ideas for assigned grade-level clusters and content areas, and enter them into a survey form (asynchronous work).
- Receive \$25 compensation for each survey completed.
