



ACCESS for ELLs Theme Generators & Standards Experts April—September 2023

The Center for Applied Linguistics (CAL) is pleased to announce upcoming opportunities for educators to be a part of the development of ACCESS for ELLs. Educators are invited to serve as *Theme Generators* and *Standards Experts* for new ACCESS for ELLs test items.

Who can participate?

Any educator who has experience working with students in grades 1–12 in a WIDA-member state during the previous two years is invited to participate.

What will educators do?

Theme Generators will:

- Complete a non-disclosure agreement (NDA).
- Watch a tutorial video to understand what types of themes can be used on ACCESS for ELLs.
- Brainstorm theme ideas for assigned grade-level clusters and content areas, and enter them into a survey form (asynchronous work).
- Receive \$25 compensation for each survey completed.

Standards Experts will:

- Complete a non-disclosure agreement (NDA).
- Watch a tutorial video to understand how to review draft test items.
- Review sets of test items for grade-level appropriateness of the language and content, and enter feedback into an electronic questionnaire (asynchronous work).
- Receive \$25 compensation for each set of test items reviewed.
